




FIG.2-TYPICAL FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE




FIG.4-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT




FIG.5 - TYPICAL THERMAL RESISTANCE VS. LEAD LENGTH
