




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TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS ($T_A = 25 \, ^{\circ}C$, unless otherwise noted)










V_{SD} - Source-to-Drain Voltage (V) Source Drain Diode Forward Voltage






On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature




Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient

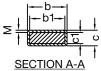
