




#### Transconductance






## **Transfer Characteristics**




#### **On-Resistance vs. Drain Current**






On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




**Source Drain Diode Forward Voltage** 



On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




**Threshold Voltage** 




**Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature**


## Safe Operating Area
