
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
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
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


R<sub>DS(on)</sub> vs. V<sub>GS</sub> vs. Temperature



Forward Diode Voltage vs. Temperature








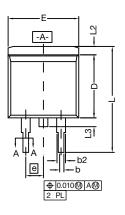
Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Case

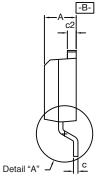
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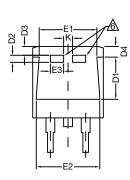

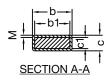
